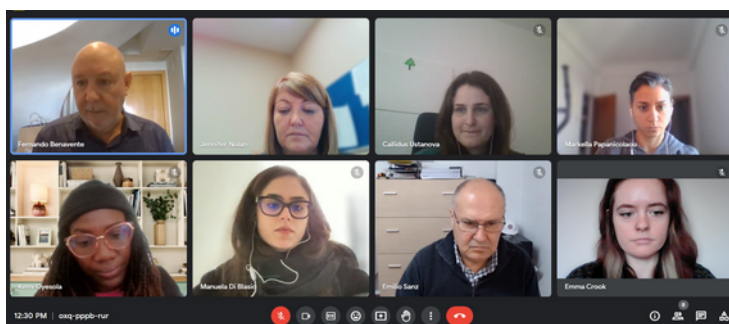
»»» ABOUT THE PROJECT

The GREEN SHOOTS Project aims to advance knowledge and pedagogy among Vocational Education and Training (VET) teachers and trainers in the context of the green economy. By leveraging the EU Green Deal and GreenComp initiatives, the project focuses on enhancing educators' pedagogical competences, particularly in technical green skills and digital education. Key activities include creating Competence Profiles for Green Careers, training 140 VET professionals, and developing a GREEN SHOOTS learning platform. Through virtual and in-person training activities, as well as dissemination events, the project seeks to improve the quality of VET offerings and support positive vocational outcomes for learners.

FIRST STEPS

»»» ONLINE PARTNER MEETING

The inaugural partner meeting was conducted virtually, during which partners collectively established the tasks and set deadlines for all work packages. It was unanimously decided that the subsequent face-to-face meeting will entail a comprehensive review of the developed materials, culminating in the agreement upon final outputs.
